That said, they were all in good condition, fit and looked splendid with their glossy coats glistening in the sunlight.

I judged to their movement as best I could and to the standard. My placing's seemed well received and I hope I have not offended any exhibitors as I judged all dogs on that day's performance. I would stress, we all take the best dog home regardless of their achievements.

# Minor Puppy Dog (1)

1<sup>ST</sup>. TEUSCHONS THE FIERCE KNIGHT WITH ELLEONIA (Sewerd) At 6 months this Bk/Rt was nicely proportioned with good depth, close elbows and straight front. Carries a good shaped head and reach of neck that flows into good layback of shoulder and firm level topline. Moved ok.

# Puppy Dog (2)

# 1ST. KRIEGERS HUNKY DORY AT MALIBRAY (Young)

A substantial very well developed Br/Rt boy at the tender age of 11 months. Liked his angulation fore and aft and his pronounced forechest, has plently of depth with close lying elbows. Pasterns are firm on tight catlike feet. Head is strong and of good proportions, neck is slightly crested and flows smoothly into the best of shoulders, firm level topline. On the move he had good reach and strong drive from his well developed rear quarters and low set hocks. Was exceptionally well handled, sure to have a bright future. **BPD** & **BPIS** 

2<sup>ND</sup>. LATEAGAIN HEART OF FIRE (Evans)

Smart Bk/Rt in good condition, carries a good head with reachy slightly crested neck leading to good layback of shoulder. Topline is level and firm. Front is straight with strong pasterns on tight compact feet. Presents a lovely profile standing and moved with purpose. Just lacks the substance of 1.

#### Junior Dog (2)

1<sup>ST</sup>. SUPETA'S BIG HUNK O'LOVE FOR DEBISON (Hutchison & Mycroft) Substantial Bk/Rt, stood square and is sound as a bell. Carries the best of heads with dark expressive eye of good shape and well placed neat ears. He's well let down in brisket with close elbows has a straight front with strong pasterns on tight compact feet. Angulation fore and aft was just right. Oozes quality, moved and handled to great advantage

#### 2<sup>ND</sup>. KITADO EVER SO FUNKY (Wright)

Nicely balanced Br/Rt of lighter frame to 1. Has a good headpeace and reachy neck with good shoulder placement. Forechest is well pronounced and front is straight with firm pasterns and tight feet. Handled well and presented in good condition.

## Yearling Dog (2)

# 1<sup>ST</sup>. COCKNEYOKA DIRE STRAIGHTS (Robertson)

Short coupled Bk/Rt with plenty of depth and good strong topline. Head is nicely proportioned with good length of foreface and is well filled under the eyes with neat well set ears. Angulation overall was good, feet were strong and compact with hocks low set and parallel. Movement going and coming was good, handled and presented very well.

# 2<sup>ND</sup>. GRAFAX OBERON AT CAMPERDOWN (Verrall)

Very square and compact with good head properties and dark expressive eye. Good reach of neck leads to a firm level topline that was maintained on the move. Stood foursquare and free ,with little help from his handler. Well presented and in prime condition.

# **Graduate Dog** (2)

1ST. KNECHT MANDEK (Downie)

Well constructed Bk/Rt with good headpiece, dark almond shaped eye and neat well placed ears. Lean reachy neck flows nicely into good layback of shoulder leading to a strong level topline. Has plenty of depth and close lying elbows. Front and rear angulation was good, moved with plenty of drive. Very well handled.

#### 2<sup>ND</sup>. JOHMAR HARLEQUIN (Bryan)

Shorter coupled than 1. Head is nicely shaped with good eye and ear set. Neck is lean leading to good shoulder placement and firm topline. Good depth of brisket with elbows well tucked in. Stood free and moved well.

### 1ST. RAFTHOUSE AMULET'S CHILD (Santoriello)

In profile this Bk/Rt looked a picture, standing foursquare and free. Carries a good headpiece and neat ears. Front is straight with elbows well tucked in. Has ample forechest and good firm level topline. Hocks are low set and parallel. Moved with purpose and well handled.

# Limit Dog (5)

# 1ST. JOJAVIK MASTER CUTLER (Woodhouse)

Stood out in this class, a Bk/Rt exuding quality. So elegant yet so strong all through. Particulary liked his headpiece and expression, the dark eye giving that look of eagles. Has a good reach of neck and good shoulders with short firm topline. Pasterns are strong on catlike feet. Moved as if he owned the ring, well presented and handled to perfection. **Res CC** 

# 2<sup>ND</sup>. DIEGO'S DENZIL WASHINGTON WITH KELJAYGO (Goodban)

Carries a good headpiece with good head planes, dark eye and neat ears. Front was straight with strong pasterns on tight feet. Has good depth and close elbows. Unlucky to meet 1 today, moved well enough, sure to do well going forward.

#### **Open Dog** (2, 1 Abs)

### 1<sup>ST</sup>. LATEAGAIN SATISFACTION JW (Lafford & Groves)

Stood alone but a quality Bk/Rt who should do well against competition. He's smart with a well proportion head, dark eyes and neat ears. Neck is reachy, nicely crested and flows smoothly into good lay of shoulder. Topline is short, firm and level. Moved ok, seemed a little distracted at times by activities outside the ring. Well handled and presented in good condition.

### **Champion Dog** (5)

### 1<sup>ST</sup>. CH MANZART WISE GUY (Hughes & Everley)

Star of the day, as soon as he entered the ring he looked special and he was. A substantial Bk/Rt stands freely, foursquare and with little help from his handler. Head properties could not be bettered with dark expressive eye and filling under, great foreface and well set small ears. Neck is lean slightly crested and flows into the best of shoulders, topline is level and strong which he retained on the move. Front is straight with strong pasterns on cat like feet and nails neatly trimmed. Brisket is well let down with elbows tucked in. Balanced throughout with good bend of stifle and low set hocks contributing to his strong purposeful drive on the move. Looks good from all angles, delighted to award him **CC & BIS** 

## 2<sup>ND</sup>. CH KORIFEY VANQUISH JW (Jones & Ushakova)

This Bk/Rt is smart and exudes quality. Has the best of heads with dark correctly shaped eyes and small high set ears. Neck is lean, slightly arched and flows smoothly into the best of shoulders. Topline is level, short and firm. Front is straight with plenty heartroom, depth of brisket is just right and elbows are well tucked in. Pasterns are strong on compact feet and hocks low set and parallel. Looked a picture standing freely, clear of his handler. Unfortunate to meet 1 today, would just prefer a little more substance. Presented and handled to perfection.

# 1ST. AMAZON BLACKPARK LOUIS VUITTON (Gregson)

In his prime I can imagine this 8 ½ year old Bk/Rt was a force to be reckoned with and it would take something special to beat him. Loved his head and kind expressive eye and ear placement.

Put on a good performance despite his advancing years and carrying a little excess weight. So sound all through with his straight front, close elbows and an abundance of depth and good topline. Rear is well angulated with low set hocks. Handled calmly and gently, moved well enough. Hope he continues showing and goes on for many more years. **BVD** 

### **Minor Puppy Bitch** (5, 2 Abs)

#### 1<sup>ST</sup>. DEBISON'S BARBRA STREISAND (Hutchison)

Compact 7 month Bk/Rt with good depth for age. Carries a feminine well proportioned head with eye of good colour and shape. Lean neck flows nicely into shoulder and level firm topline. Pasterns are strong on tight feet. Would prefer a little more turn of stifle and better rear movement. That said, she's a nice youngster who was well presented and handled.

### 2<sup>ND</sup>. COCKNEYOKA VENTURA (Robertson)

Br/Rt at 8 months, stands taller than 1. Has a good head with eye of acceptable colour and shape. Overall she is well conformed with straight front and good feet. Again, would prefer better rear angulation providing better positive movement going.

# Puppy Bitch (3)

# 1ST. KRIEGERS HIGHLAND FLING (Bisland)

Br/Rt at just 11 months presents a perfect picture standing free. Has plenty depth for her age with pronounced forechest. Neck is lean and crested and flows smoothly to the best of shoulders and short firm level topline. Front is straight with elbows well tucked in, pasterns are strong on tight catlike feet. Has great strength to the rear with lovely sweep of stifle and low set hocks which she put to great use. She is quality and will be surprised if she doesn't have a bright future. Moved with ease and power, well handled by her young handler. **BPB** & **RBPIS** 

# 2<sup>ND</sup>. JOJAVIK PHOTOBOMB (Ingram & Lack)

9 months Bk/Rt, lighter build and stood taller than 1. Has a well proportioned head with good eye shape and colour. Ample depth to close lying elbows with good angulation fore and aft and level topline. She has a good turn of stifle and low set hocks. Presented in good condition and moved well.

#### 3<sup>RD.</sup> LATEAGAIN WILD HEASRT AVEC SARIANDOBES (Lafford)

### Junior Bitch (5)

#### 1<sup>ST</sup>. SUPETA'S POCKETFUL OF LOVE FOR SHARHYSTE (Mycroft)

At 14 months this compact Bk/Rt stands foursquare and is not short of substance and elegance. Carries the best of heads with good foreface and is well filled under the eye. Angulation overall is ideal with short firm topline and low set hocks that were parallel and perpendicular to the ground. Move with purpose and drive, handled to advantage.

### 2<sup>ND</sup>. MANZART YULIANA AT WHIZZBEAN (Pollard)

A lot to like about this 12 month Bk/Rt, just not quite the substance and head properties of 1. She's of good conformation with straight front, strong pasterns on tight feet and ok rear angulation. Neck is lean and reachy and flows into well placed shoulders and level firm topline. Handled and presented calmly and to advantage.

1<sup>ST</sup>. DEBISON'S BARBRA STREISAND (Hutchison) As Minor Puppy.

# 2<sup>ND</sup>. KITADO EVER SO TIPSY (Hallows)

Smart in profile with lighter frame to 1. Pleasing headpiece with nice ear set. Neck flows nicely into good shoulders through to strong level topline. Front is straight with elbows tucked in and firm pasterns. Seemed to enjoy her day albeit a little over exuberant at times, moved and handled well.

**Graduate Bitch** (1, 1Wd)

#### 1ST. DIEGO'S DORIS DAY (Freer & McCall)

Short coupled Bk/Rt with pleasing head, dark eye and neat ears. Has a good level topline, straight front and strong rear quarters that she used to advantage on the move. Elbows are well tucked and pasterns are strong on compact feet. Stood foursquare on loose lead with little prompting.

### Limit Bitch (9)

#### 1ST. GRACELAND CHOCOLATE DROP (Shaw)

This Br/Rt looked a picture today, in tip top condition with coat gleaming in the sun. Has good head qualities with neat well place ears and almond shaped eye of good colour giving a lovely keen expression. Neck is lean, strong, crested and reachy flowing smoothly into well laid back shoulders and firm level topline. Front was straight with good width and close lying elbows to well let down brisket. Rear angulation was good and strong with just the right amount of turn of stifle and low set hocks that were perpendicular to the ground and parallel when viewed from the rear. On the move she had good reach and strong rear drive whilst maintaining a level topline. Put on a fantastic performance today, was well presented and handled. **CC & BOS** 

## 2<sup>ND.</sup> SUPETA'S DIAMOND IN THE SKY (Mycroft)

Bk/Rt, similar attributes apply as 1. She's a good size with substance and well proportioned head, good headplanes and dark expressive eye. Angulation fore and aft was good as was her lean strong reachy neck and firm level topline. Front was straight with strong pasterns on compact feet. Moved reasonably well and handled with expertise.

# Open Bitch (7, 2 Abs)

# 1<sup>ST</sup>. MANZRT VOODOO MAGIC JW (Everley)

This Bk/Rt is quality through and through. Has a lovely headpiece with good head planes, dark keen expressive eyes and neat well placed ears. Neck is a good length, crested and flows smoothly into the best of shoulders to a short level topline. Angulation fore and aft was just right with good straight front, plenty of depth and tight elbows. Pasterns were strong on the tightest of feet with neatly

trimmed nails. On the move she did not disappoint, she had reach and drive. She will do well going forward, I'm sure. Well handled and presented. **Res CC** 

#### 2<sup>ND</sup>. JODASEEN CARDINAL ENVY (Sanderson)

Standard size and well proportioned, not quite the elegance and demeanor of 1, but a good example of the breed. Has a good head, reach of neck with good shoulders and level topline. Front was straight with strong pasterns and has a good turn of stifle and strong rear quarters that she used on the move. Well handled and presented in fine form.

3<sup>RD</sup>. JOJAVIK FORGET ME NOT JW SHCM (Ingram)

### **Champion Bitch** (2, 1 Abs)

#### 1ST. CH KORIFEY OKSANA (Bishop)

Stood alone, her quality cannot be denied. This Bk/Rt stands freely and foursquare with very little assistance from her handler, looking a picture from all angles. Has a lovely head with good head planes, keen dark expressive eyes and good ear placement. Neck flows into well laid back shoulders leading to a short level topline. Front is straight and of good width, elbows are close to a good depth of brisket and pasterns firm on catlike feet. Moved well and handled to perfection.

# **Veteran Bitch** (2, 1 Abs)

# 1<sup>ST</sup>. CH ASHLAIN TRYPITI JW SHCM (Lainchbury)

At 7 years this quality Bk/Rt is in tip top condition and full of life belying her advancing years. She is a credit to her owners / breeders, stands foursquare and is well balanced. She has a well proportioned head with good head planes, dark almond shaped eyes and well placed neat ears. Has a good reach of neck and well placed shoulders leading to a short firm topline. Angulation fore and aft is just right and the strength from the rear gave her tremendous drive. Was well handled and presented in fantastic condition, well done. **BVB** & **BVIS**
