Having been away from the breed for a number of years it was good to come back and see what I have missed along with to have a look first hand at what direction the breed is heading? Some changes have taken place within the breed, (I have judged a number of occasions since docking of tails has stopped, this took me a while to get used to, although I am getting there on that issue) I found some good traits and some not so much. I found that the size of a some plus a lack of elegance was evident in a number of exhibits the breed standard states substantial yet elegant' we must bear this in mind moving forward. Generally, the females were more to type whilst some of the males were very varied. Overall, I was pleased with temperaments which have really improved which was good to see along with a good bone density, the depth and spring of ribcage and dentition & bite were generally good. Over angulation also seems a bit of an issue with some exhibits. The weather conditions coupled with the long layoff due to the restrictions set upon us led to a number of exhibits not showing the propulsive rear drive I was looking for although most were sound enough in that department.

- 1) Robertson's Cockneyoka Dire Straits 9 months very promising baby, lovely balanced head, nice depth of muzzle, eyes and ears with nice expression, well arched neck, smart in appearance displaying a nice shape, good top-line, correct upper arm & good lay of shoulder, good front and fore-chest, with nice cat like tight feet, correct rear angulation with a good turn of stifle, retained his shape on the move, BPD
- 2) Santoriello's Rafthouse Amulets Child, B&T, slightly taller than 1st, nice rich tan markings, pushed hard for 1st came down to splitting hairs, well-muscled, good front, nice head, well placed shoulders, gently sloping topline, smart appearance, he moved like youngster enjoying his day out
- 3) Edyveane's Jojavik Snowpiercer

- 1) Jones & Ushakova's Korifey Vanquish 13 ½ months, quite mature for his age B&T Good head, excellent dark eye, flowing clean neck into a good lay-back of shoulder, good strong front & forechest, tight catlike feet, good top-line & tailset, strong rear, well-muscled quarters. Also won ND.

- 1) Korifey Emporer, 14 months old, a tall brown male with a lovely rich colour, smart outline with good front assembly & forechest, tight catlike feet, nice depth of brisket, well placed shoulders, moved well

- 1) Bradbury's Jodaseen Bootylicious 21 months very smart in appearance, presenting a lovely outline with good topline & Tailset, good wedge-shaped head, with expression, plenty of forechest, nice and deep brisket, sound fore & aft allowing a flowing movement
- 2) Brough's Sharhyste Maid in The Purple for Aniraz, Another smart B&T B good front, with a nice head, eye & neck good shoulder placement, well constructed, deep brisket, nice spring of rib plenty of forechest

- 1) Nicol's Sharhyste Lady Winterfell at Evenjays Pretty 2 yr old B&T B good blunt wedged head, eye shape, clean arched neck, sound front, smart outline with good depth, and angulation fore and aft enabling her to move freely

Post Graduate Bitch

- 1) Kings Nerak Rewrite The Stars Lovely wedge head with almond eyes, uses her ears well, proper feminine 2 year old well balanced exhibit well developed forechest, elegant without being overdone in any way, adequate depth of brisket will improve even more with maturity, super angulation for & aft shows a lovely silhouette with lovely neck, topline & tailset. With a good spring of rib. A well-balanced exhibit, will take some stopping with a little more maturity RCC
- 2) Branan's Supeta's Whole Lotta Rosie with Sharhyste JW, another super exhibit pushed hard for 1st, well constructed throughout, nice rich brown colour, lovely head and eye, compact body shape proportionate throughout, good shoulders and angulation, well muscled

- 1) Barber's Ch Amazon Chanel for Alcumlow, Eye catching whilst not exaggerated in any way, smart 4 yr old B&T bitch caught my eye straight away, superb outline elegant with the correct amount of substance, well balanced with great top line & tailset stands 4 square, good head with alert expression, sound in front with ample bone, well filled croup good spring of rib, ample depth of brisket, super angulation F & A showed her socks off well done BCC, BIS
- 2) Ingram & Hendersons CH Jojavik Poison Ivy what a class this was, another high-quality exhibit, splitting hairs for 1st place, slightly taller than 1st, super outline, presenting a lovely picture, very good depth of brisket, well sprung ribs, hocks are strong and well let down, lovely bone, felt she rushed on the move overbalancing her, another superb specimen

Veteran Bitch

- 1) CH Remesca's Reet Petite ShCM lovely 8 ½ years old Brown bitch, again very smart in appearance, excellent topline & tailset, ample depth of brisket with a good forechest, moved well in the heat well done BVB
- 2) Mycroft's Supeta's Spells Trouble JW ShCM very nice 8 ½ years old lovely head and expression nice rich markings a well put together exhibit, Well handled
